

Friends of Art History in Focus – Subscription

After registering, you are able to subscribe. Subscription enables you to benefit from the features outlined in the Friends of Art History in Focus section of the website. These website features will be accessible only upon subscription payment. If you decide to become a Friend, and therefore pay our annual Full Membership fee, you are agreeing to take the annual Full Membership we make available to you promptly after that fee is paid. However, you may apply for a full refund by emailing to info@arthistoryinfocus.com or by writing to us at PO Box 1509, Woking GU23 6XE within a cooling-off period of 7 working days of receipt of the initial subscription payment or within 7 working days of any renewal (as detailed below). Refunds may only otherwise be given at the discretion of Art History in Focus. The cost of subscription is that advertised and Art History in Focus reserves the right to refuse applications without giving a reason.

Your Full Membership will be automatically renewed at the end of the year and your card will be automatically debited via Paypal. Art History in Focus reserves the right to change the Membership price at short notice as well as the period which it covers, the services which it enables you to obtain and other factors from time to time. However, rest assured that these changes will not affect your then-current Full Membership and you may of course cancel your account when the renewal date is due if you do not accept these changes.

The annual individual membership fee is £89. Couples and Friends living at the same address may benefit from a reduced joint subscription of £149.00.

Notice will be given in advance, via the newsletter, of a number of alternative dates which are scheduled for the Friends' Only Study Days. Friends will be asked to select a date of their choice in advance, at least 4 weeks ahead of the study day they wish to attend. Spaces are limited to one ticket per individual member, and one event per year (therefore two tickets per joint membership and one event per year – joint members can attend different events if they wish). If a Friend is unable to make any of the annual events on offer, they may transfer the booking to someone else provided that we are given full details in writing and at least 48 hours notice.

Friends have access to a priority booking list for all Art History in Focus events, including holidays and study days. When booking opens, there will be a period, normally two weeks, in which Friends will have first right of refusal on all spaces. Priority spaces are limited to two spaces per tour, and four spaces per study day, course or event per membership (both individual and joint). Places are allocated on a first come, first served basis. Please note that due to high demand for tours and events we cannot always guarantee availability.

Friends' names will be automatically entered in a quarterly prize draw. Recipients' names and prizes may be mentioned, unless you would prefer to remain anonymous, in the Friends' quarterly newsletter.

Friends will also be invited to an annual Summer Friends' Lunch and the date will be published in advance in the Friends' quarterly newsletter. The event is arranged for Friends only. Art History in Focus will organise the event which will take place at an exclusive members' only club in London, although the cost of the lunch itself is not included in the Membership Fee.

Friends may also enjoy advantages on Art History in Focus tours such as, by way of example, free/discounted room upgrades if these happen to become available. Please note that this is not a guarantee that such advantages will become available, but if they do so then Friends will be the first to benefit.
